UPDATE SIRES OF MULTI-SIRE ANIMALS BY IMPORTING

When you have an animal which is born from a multi-sire joining, you may now update a file or a list from your DNA testing group to determine which sire is the actual sire. You may now update the actual sire to a calf from DNA by using an imported CSV file.

FILE REQUIREMENTS

The file to update your calves MUST be as follows:

No headers or missing lines, must be in CSV format.

Column1 = Calf Tag

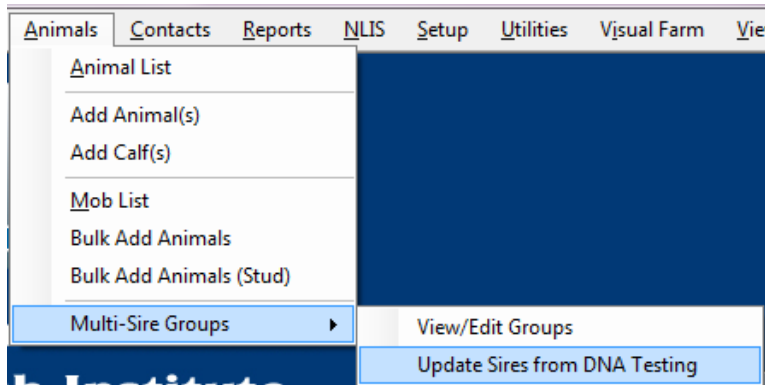
Column 2 = Actual Sire Tag

Eg:

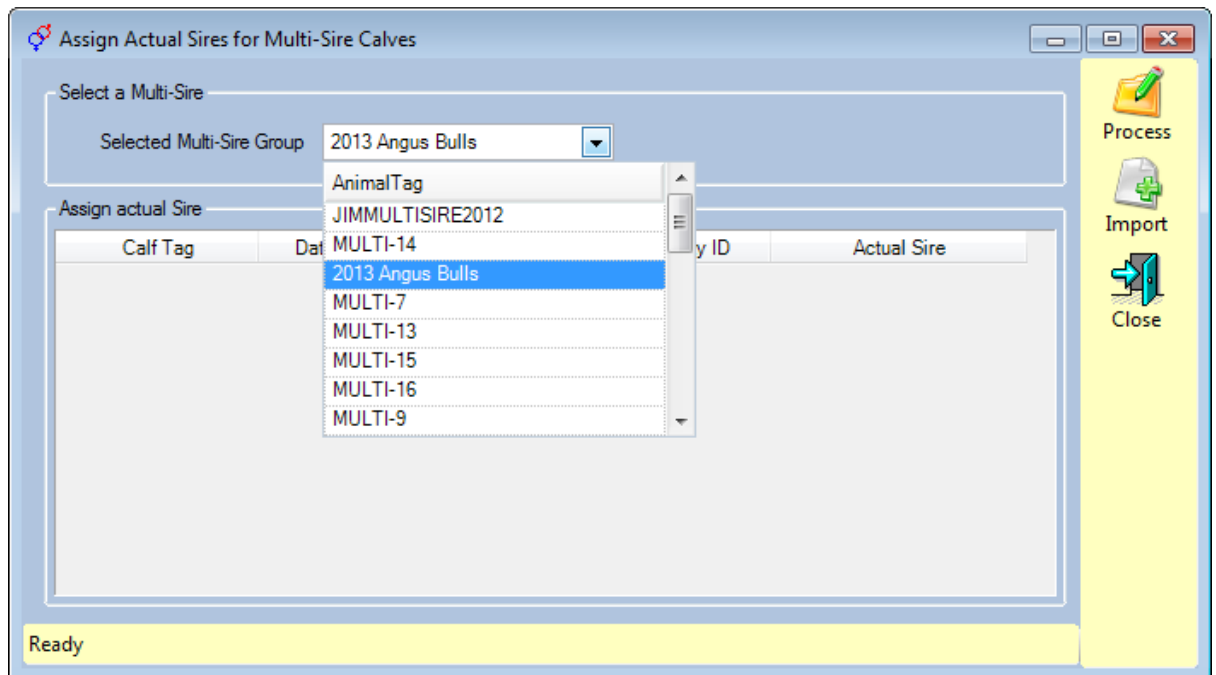

BULK ASSIGNING THE ACTUAL SIRE FROM MULTI-SIRE GROUPS

Open the Assignment window from **Animals | Multi-Sire groups | Update Sires from DNA Testing**



1. Select the Mutli-Sire the calves are from from the drop-down list



2. A list of all the calves still assigned to that multi-sire will be displayed, hit the import button and select your second file that contains the calf tag and the actual sire tag only.
3. The list will update with the sire ID from the file, check your list to make sure it is assigning them correctly.
4. When you believe it is correct hit the **process** button. The calves will be assigned to their correct sire now.
